

Call for submissions. Journal *Clivatge* #4

Reception period of articles for the next issue of *Clivatge* #4 is open.

As you already know, we are basically interested in *analyses* of recent social phenomena related to situations of social change and conflict. We also expect to receive writings which are testimony of social movements, platforms or organizations, of their actions of protest or social innovations. Equally, we expect to get reviews of recent works connected with our journal's subjects.

In this issue, we shall prioritize articles dealing with the following topics:

1. The **crisis of the European project**, in its several dimensions –socioeconomic and geopolitical aspects, issues connected to policies of political asylum, and political issues in general–: oppositional dynamics and signs of governance failure such as the mobilizations in favour of abandoning the euro, the problems to manage migration processes, the confrontational lines between the EU and Greece, etc.
2. Denunciations of injustice and demands for **social change in Latin America**.
3. Foreseeable (or announced) **political changes in Latin America**.
4. "Delayed" perception of the social and economic effects of the **crisis** around the world.

Formal guidelines for paper submission:

Language: Catalan, English, Spanish and/or French, without distinction.

Fonts:

a) Main text: Arial 12

b) Quoted text: Arial 11

c) Footnotes: Arial 10

Bibliographical references in the text: author-comma-space-year-colon-page number, as in: (Offe, 1978:25) or (Offe & Wiesenthal, 1984:56).

References at the end of the article: These should follow the example in the article by Antonio Hermosilla, "El papel de las movilizaciones...", pp. 24 and ff. in *Clivatge* 1.

Extension: 2.000 to 20.000 words.

Author's biographical note: It should be included as a footnote on the first page and its length should not exceed 2-3 lines.

Copyright: All papers must be original and for exclusive publication by the Observatory. Accepted papers will be made available to the public free of charge. The Observatory reserves the right to publish them additionally in printed format, always respecting the integrity of the text and after communication to the author/s.

Reception period for papers is until 20 February, 2016.

Estem preparant el proper número 3 de la revista *Clivatge. Estudis i testimonis del conflicte i el canvi socials*. El tema central d'aquesta nova entrega girarà al voltant de l'anàlisi de la desigualtat social present a les societats actuals (el títol provisional del número monogràfic serà "Un nou examen de la desigualtat social"). Se seleccionaran i publicaran articles o treballs d'anàlisi sobre les condicions de pobresa, els nous contextos i processos en què s'articulen classes i conflictes de classe, les condicions relatives i especials de desigualtat que imposen un caràcter nou a grups, col·lectius i minories socials (immigrants, jubilats, dones, jovent, etc.), els efectes de l'atur i la precarietat laboral en les condicions que perfilen actualment la desigualtat... Estem igualment interessats a rebre anàlisis que vinculin les noves condicions de desigualtat socials amb els conflictes socials, així com amb les estratègies socials innovadores que persegueixen una sortida a la crisi actual i les seves conseqüències. L'objecte d'anàlisi empírica dels treballs pot ser de diferent i divers àmbit geogràfic (països, regions o continents diferents), atès que el nostre objectiu és aportar amb aquesta entrega un coneixement tant variat com sigui possible sobre les circumstàncies presents i els efectes que l'actual crisi està tenint sobre la diversitat de realitats i poblacions que habiten el planeta.

Els articles originals poden estar escrits, indistintament, en castellà, català, anglès o francès.

We are currently preparing the third issue of our journal *Clivatge. Estudis i testimonis del conflicte i el canvi socials* [Cleavage. Studies and Testimonies Regarding Social Conflict and Change]. This new issue of *Clivatge* will revolve around the analysis of the social inequalities affecting present-day societies (under the provisional title “A new examination of social inequality”). For this monograph, we will select for publication articles and papers dealing with the new conditions of poverty, the new processes and contexts along which classes and class conflicts are organized, the relative and special conditions of inequality which confer a new character to social groups and minorities (such as immigrants, retired people, women, youth...), the effects of unemployment and job insecurity on the conditions shaping inequality nowadays... We will also welcome papers dealing with the relationship between the new realities of social inequality, on one hand, and social conflict, on the other, with special attention to the emergence of innovative social strategies in the search for a way out of the current crisis and its consequences. The empirical cases analysed in the papers may be multifarious and of different geographical origins (different areas, countries, regions or continents), as it is our goal to provide a broad view on the circumstances and social effects of the current crisis on the very diverse realities and populations in our planet.

Original papers may be written in English, French, Spanish or Catalan.
